

### DAY ONE YATTENDON & HUNGERFORD



The award-winning West Berkshire Brewery, just outside the village of Yattendon near Newbury, is a fascinating microbrewery founded in 1995 in an old dairy farm. Pre-arranged 50-minute guided tours (hourly from 11am to 3pm) provide an insight into brewing process, from hops to canning and bottling.


About half an hour's drive west is the award-winning Alder Ridge Vineyard just outside Hungerford across slopes of the North Wessex Downs whose chalky soil is not dissimilar to the Champagne region of France. Tours of about 45 minutes are often available between May and September with prior booking. Have lunch at the adjacent Cobbs Farm, from a seasonal menu that might include salmon mousse with beetroot and sourdough chips and asparagus straight from the farm.

Drive about 15 minutes south to reach Wilton Windmill standing spectacularly above the pretty village of Wilton. Open for pre-booked guided tours on Sunday and Bank Holiday Monday afternoons from Easter to the end

of September. Then journey on through the beautiful Pewsey Valley to East Chisenbury and enjoy a circular walk of about a mile and a half along the Kennet & Avon Canal passing Crofton Pumping Station on the way – between April and the start of October groups of up to 50 people can arrange a tour to see inside this fascinating site of industrial steam heritage.



**COACH PARKING Marlborough:** George Lane car park. **Devizes:** Wharf car park and Station Road car park for long stay. #### DAYTWO MARLBOROUGH OR DEVIZES

Choose between two top breweries to visit: Ramsbury Brewing near Marlborough, which has been creating artisan beer since 2004; 1.5 hours guided tour on Wednesdays and Fridays, starting at 11am; alternatively,



head to Wadworth Brewery in Devizes, which was founded in 1875 and where you'll get a tremendous sense of brewing history at its landmark Victorian property. There's a visitor centre with a 'brewsmuseum' where you'll learn about traditional brewing techniques. Pre-booked guided tours are at 11am or 2pm; there's a great deal to see during the two or so hours of the show around, which takes you on a fun and informative journey through various buildings, from 19thcentury tower to 21st-century copper house.

Head south to a'Beckett's Vineyard at the hamlet of Littleton Panell. With 11 acres of vines it is the Great West Way's largest vineyard – as yet – and it also produces apples and pears. It's a family-run concern, founded in 2001 and making acclaimed sparkling wine, roses, still whites and some pinot noir vintages, many available in the shop. Groups welcome Mondays and Tuesdays.

#### DAY THREE BRADFORD ON AVON AND KENNET & AVON CANAL

Drop by Hartley Farm Shop and Kitchen just north of Bradford on Avon, where you'll take in a fabulous spread of local produce and can also enjoy coffee and homemade cake. Then head into



the heart of town for more epicurean exploration. Then make tracks to the Canal Trust Café for lunch, which accepts pre-booked groups of up to 20. Set in a former lock keeper's cottage, this retro-cosy restaurant offers toasted sandwiches, homemade beef burgers and more. Take a walk along the Kennet & Avon Canal here looking out for kingfishers and waterfowl such as chestnutcoloured little grebes.

Consider end the trip with a detour to the Bombay Sapphire Distillery at Laverstock Mill. Group visits showcase the great care, skill and artistry that go into the gin-making process, including a visit to the iconic glasshouses designed by Thomas Heatherwick where you'll learn about the vapour-infusion distillation process and discover the flavours of the botanicals that make Bombay Sapphire gin so unique.
